

2020 BBRS COVID-19 Event Rules

1. All entries must be received prior to events to eliminate office congestion, please enter online at the BBRS website. Visit the respective event you wish to enter and then follow the link to the entry form. You may also text the BBRS Secretary with Rider, Horse, Division, and time only count (if any) at 406-598-3297 as early as the day prior to the race (Tuesdays).
2. Payment will be accepted by way of cash or check, placed in an envelope with the rider, horse(s), and division labeled, and placed in a designated drop box near the respective arena office. You may also detail this information on the check memo section or attach a sort of document to the fees with information.
3. If you need to come to the office, we require that you use the hand sanitization station set up prior to. Only one person is allow in the office at a time. No more than two people may be in line outside the office and must stand at a minimum of six feet apart.
4. Contestants are to park 12 feet apart from one another.
5. No one may attend any of the events if they are ill or demonstrate any symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., fever, unexplained cough, and/or shortness of breath).
6. Contestants are required to stay with their truck and trailer until prior to their competition draw positions and must return immediately following.
7. If an event is to be held at an indoor facility, no more than five (5) contestants will be permitted into the facility at any given time and will remain a minimum of six (6) feet apart.
8. For warm up, you are welcome to ride as much as needed as long as you stay horseback, do not congregate anywhere, and remain a minimum distance of six feet apart.
9. All family members or traveling partners are required to stay at their vehicle until their person is competing. At that time, they may approach the arena fence to observe and return to their vehicle immediately following.
10. No more than four (4) to a group at any given time while practicing social distancing.
11. There will be no seating provided at any of the arenas.
12. There will be a hand sanitization station near the arena gate.
13. Results will be posted at the BBRS website.
14. Winnings will be mailed to contestants the following day.
15. No out-of-state contestants will be allowed to enter any event until the 14-day quarantine for people coming into stay deemed by the state governor expires.
16. All rules must be strictly followed or you will be asked to leave.
